Regional Security Leadership

Egypt and the U.S. are cooperating closely to de-escalate conflicts and promote sustainable peace throughout the Middle East and North Africa.

- ▶ Joint U.S.-Egypt operations and exercises: Operation Bright Star, Eagle Defender, Red Sea Maritime Task Force
- ▶ Close collaboration to combat terrorism and piracy.
- ▶ U.S. access to Egyptian airspace + Suez Canal.
- ▶ Egypt-U.S. intelligence sharing.



Diplomatic Leadership

Egypt and the U.S. have been key interlocutors to resolve conflict and address ongoing crisis across the Middle East.

- ▶ Leadership on negotiating a ceasefire in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and establishing a permanent two-state solution.
- ▶ Restoring a civilian-led transition in Sudan
- ▶ Engaged on resolving GERD issue in Ethiopia
- ▶ Collaborate in international peacekeeping forces.



Growing Economic Ties

Egypt and the U.S. have a shared commitment to strengthening bilateral economic cooperation through expanding trade, private sector investments, and clean energy and climate technology.

- ▶ \$8.6 B of U.S. trade to Egypt, its 3rd largest partner.
- ▶ \$6.1 B exports from U.S. to Egypt.
- ▶ 1,000+ U.S. companies do business in Egypt.
- ▶ \$5.9 billion Egypt imports from the U.S. to modernize Egyptian infrastructure.



Promoting Rich Culture + Tourism

Egypt and the U.S. are committed partners in preserving, restoring, and protecting Egypt's cultural heritage.

- ▶ Bilateral agreement that strengthens protections for cultural heritage.
- ▶ Cooperation to stop trafficking of artifacts and cultural objects.
- ▶ 208,000 U.S. tourists in 2023 and 20,000 Egyptians have participated in U.S. exchange programs.
